How you can stop the Senate Republicans

Senate Republicans are on the verge of dismantling the Affordable Care Act, one of the most progressive political achievements in a generation. There were no women involved in crafting the bill, and no public hearings. There is good chance the vote will be called this week.

2. **Call NJ Senators Booker and Menendez:** Call everyday, until this bill is defeated. They oppose the bill, but urge them to do more: Tell them to “filibuster by amendment.” The Republicans are using a process called “reconciliation” to pass the law. This means that under Senate rules the bill is not subject to filibuster; Republicans need only 50 votes. However, an unlimited number of amendments are allowed. Democratic Senators should plan thousands of amendments until Republicans agree to have public hearings on the bill.

Some FACTS about the consequences of Republican “health care reform” in New Jersey:

- Through Medicaid cuts and the loss of health insurance subsidies, **540,000 New Jerseyans would lose their health insurance.**
- 95% of New Jerseyans would not get a tax cut, but **the wealthiest 5% would receive a total of \$13 billion** over 10 years.
- 54,000 New Jerseyans with jobs tied to Medicaid and tax credits would lose their jobs
- New Jersey would lose \$6.6 billion in economic activity.
- New Jersey taxpayers would have to pay \$27 billion more annually in taxes to cover the health care needs of its citizens.
